

Wesel's know-how demanded in Canada – Soventix continues international expansion

- Soventix continues its successful development in Canada
- Implementation of solar power plants in Ontario with a total capacity of 1.2 MWp
- Closed framework agreement for projects with a volume of 6.3 MWp
- Attractive prospects for Soventix in Canada

July 14, 2016, Wesel – SOVENTIX GmbH, an internationally operating project developer and solar power plant operator, continues its successful development in the Canadian solar market. With the commissioning of two solar power plants with a total capacity of 1.2 MWp SOVENTIX has to date connected 13 solar power plants to the grid in Canada. In addition, the basis for further growth has been laid with the conclusion of a framework agreement for the development and implementation of projects with an output volume of 6.3 MWp. Partners in this framework with Soventix include SolarShare, the largest renewable energy co-operative for solar energy in Canada, and Endura Energy Projects Corp (Endura), a leading Canadian EPC company that is part of the renewable energy group, UGE International. “With our vast experience and worldwide references Soventix is a highly sought after cooperation partner in Canada too“, said Claas Fierlings, Managing Director of Soventix GmbH.

Implementation of solar power plants in Ontario with a volume of 1,2 MWp

The two projects recently connected are located in Milton, Ontario – each have an output volume of 600 kWp. After a few months of construction the free-field solar power plants were put into operation in Q1 2016. Both plants supply around 100 households with environmentally friendly electricity. The project utilizes a single-axis tracking system that was designed in Germany, which permanently aligns the module surface through a vertical axis towards the current position of the sun. A particular challenge for these projects lay in the high regional requirements that lead to an intensive planning and coordination with local authorities, environmental bodies and power authorities.

Framework agreement for projects with a volume of 6,3 MWp

Through its longstanding partnership with Endura, Soventix will complete the development and implementation of a portfolio of 11 solar power plants in the Ontario region with a combined output volume of 6,3 MWp. This includes ten free-field plants with a capacity of 600 kWp and one free-field installation of 300 kWp. The solar parks have been financed and are now entering construction, with commissioning expected to roll through 2016 into 2017. After completion these projects will be handed over to SolarShare. Michael Kendon, CEO of Soventix Canada said: “The positive development of our business in Canada fills me with confidence and we are well positioned for continued growth.”

Attractive prospects for Soventix in Canada



The Canadian solar market offers Soventix attractive prospects through the Ontario FiT (feed-in-tariff) program. A current round of contracts are expected to be awarded at the end of June 2016, while another tendering phase is expected at the end of the year. “Besides the projects in Ontario, interesting opportunities are opening up for us in the Province of Alberta, which is also planning a local renewable energy program. “We are planning to expand our regional activities accordingly and are excited about the prospects and further growth in our operations“, says Michael Kendon.
